Dr. Tichaona Nyamundaya is an experienced public health professional, with over ten years of experience implementing HIV prevention, care and treatment projects and collaborating with varied stakeholders to develop national guidelines and tools for ART, MCH integration, and TB control. He has been responsible for ensuring that clinical mentorship is expanded to all provinces in Zimbabwe and scaling up pediatric HIV care and treatment. He has been instrumental in rapidly rolling out of WHO 2010 and WHO 2013 guidelines.

He was also responsible for strengthening community linkages through the development and rollout of the tracking and tracing standard operating procedures to ensure retention in care and treatment.
