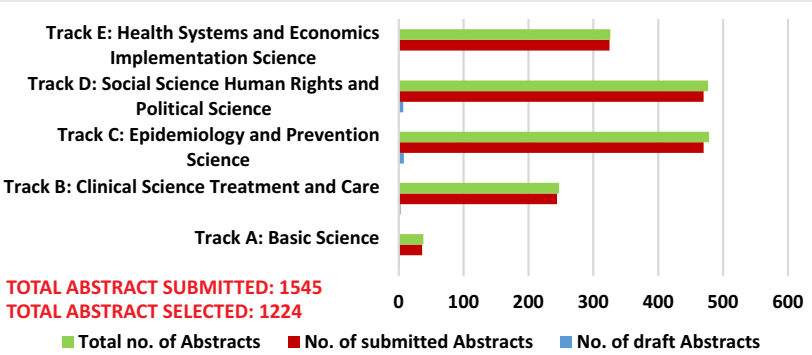

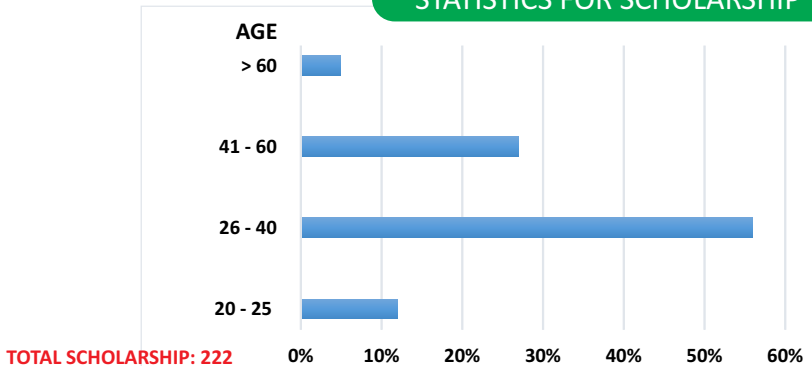

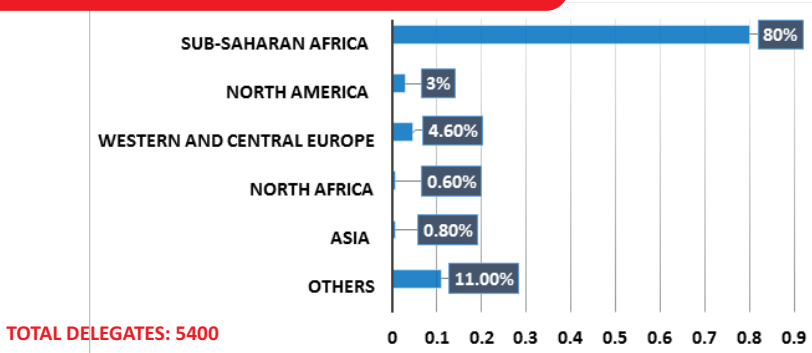
STATISTICS FOR ABSTRACT
