## ICASA 2025 CALL FOR THEME AND OBJECTIVES

### PROCESS OF PRE-SELECTION OF ICASA 2025 THEME AND OBJECTIVES

Based on the recommendation of the preselection committee to facilitate the shortlisting of the ICASA 2025 Theme and Objectives, the following decisions were taken:

- 1. All proposed theme without proposed objectives were disregarded
- 2. All proposed objective without theme were disregarded
- 3. Out of 167 proposals only 77 were considered based on the criteria

However, the committee further instructed the SAA Secretariat to screen the 77 proposals and propose the best with respect to the criteria.

- 4. 35 out of the 77 proposals were shortlisted for final selection at the 1st ISC meeting. The 35 proposals were classified as thus:
- A. 14 out of 25 proposals contained a theme and 5 objectives.
- B. 11 out 15 proposals contained a theme and more than 5 objectives.
- C. 10 out 37 proposals contained a theme and less than 5 objectives.

NB: The remaining 42 will feature as an appendix to the 1st ISC working document for your perusal.

Each programme committee working group shortlisted a theme and a set of objectives (5 objectives) for deliberation at the plenary. All members of the International Steering committee unanimously validated the following:

**ICASA 2025 THEME:** Africa in Action: Catalyzing Integrated Sustainable Responses to end AIDS, TB and Malaria.

### **ICASA 2025 OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Catalysing Africa's progress towards triple elimination and sustainable resilient health systems through innovation and digital technologies.
- 2. Promote cooperation among governments, communities, private sector, and international organizations to enhance health security and improve pandemic preparedness and response.
- 3. Strengthen capacity and facilitate knowledge exchange for healthcare professionals, researchers, and policymakers.
- 4. Empower communities and promote human rights and gender equality in the context of HIV/AIDS and emerging and reemerging diseases.
- 5. Mobilize domestic resources and political commitment to sustain Africa's progress towards achieving the UNAIDS 95-95-95 targets and global health security goals.

As part of the upcoming activities leading to the 2nd International Steering committee meeting from 28<sup>th</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025, the ICASA Secretariat is pleased to announce the ICASA 2025 call for propositions for concurrent sessions.

The Call will be launched from 27<sup>th</sup> January 2025. The deadline for submission is 15<sup>th</sup> March 2025. The secretariat is expecting members to submit 1 thematic, 3 speakers and 3 back up speakers. Each speaker has 15min of presentation.

Each session is scheduled for 45 minutes with a maximum of 3 speakers. As such, the three ICASA 2025 Programme committees are required to provide the following number of sessions per session type:

# INVITATIONAL BID TO HOST THE 24<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON AIDS AND STIS IN AFRICA (ICASA 2027)

The Society for AIDS in Africa (SAA), represented by its President; Hon. Dr. David Pagwesese Parirenyatwa, hereby invites African countries wishing to host the 24<sup>th</sup> International Conference on AIDS and STIs in Africa in 2027 (ICASA 2027) to send in their application bid document to the SAA Secretariat in Accra- Ghana. The closing date for submission of the Application is Thursday, 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025.

ICASA 2027 will be the 24<sup>th</sup> edition of the International Conference on AIDS and STIs in Africa, to be organised by the Society for AIDS in Africa (SAA).

Any **African country** is eligible to be considered to host ICASA. However, certain criteria must be fulfilled to qualify for selection.

The procedure for application is as follows:

STEP 1

Interested countries should submit a bid document of intent to the SAA Secretariat backed up with

detailed proof of evidence of the following information:

1. Strong Government support: financial commitment and political will to host the conference.

Provide and financially support the Conference venue: Capacity of Plenary rooms: 5000

Provide financial support for the local Secretariat working with the International secretariat.

seats with at least 5 break way rooms with a capacity from 150 to 1500 seats.

• Provide Scholarships for at least 500 local Participants.

2. Availability of standard hotels to accommodate up to 10,000 participants as well as conference

venue(s) with standard conference facilities.

3. Good transportation network within the country.

4. Good telecommunication network within the host country with links to other African countries

and international communities.

5. Presence of cohorts of scientific, leadership, civil societies, organised groups of PLHIV, private

sector, and youth organisations oriented towards HIV/AIDS-related activities.

6. Easy access by air and by the road where needed.

7. Recognizable presence of Government organ/body responsible for HIV/AIDS coordination in

the country.

8. Good security network to guarantee participants' safety.

9. Guarantee easy visa facilities and assistance to conference participants and no restriction to

entry for PLHIV, MSM and other minority groups.

10. Political stability.

11. No discriminatory government policies based on gender, HIV status and religion.

### STEP 2

- (a) Submitted applications will be evaluated by Society for AIDS in Africa (SAA) paid members, whereby 2 countries will be pre-selected based on meeting the criteria as listed in Step 1.
- (b) Assessment visits will be conducted by 3 SAA's Council members to the preselected countries. The preselected countries will invite SAA for the two days assessment visit 15<sup>th</sup> September 2025 to 26<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

### Please note:

- The pre-selection process will be concluded from 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025, followed by the notification to the 2 countries.
- II. After SAA Council members' assessment visit and deliberation, the host country of ICASA 2027 will be notified on the Friday, 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025, followed by a press communiqué/release.
- III. Before the official announcement of the host country of ICASA 2027, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) will be signed between the selected country and Society for AIDS in Africa (SAA), the organiser of ICASA.
- IV. SAA President is ICASA 2027 Chair; the host country will appoint a Co-chair for ICASA 2027 in consultation with SAA. The Council reserves the right to revoke the hosting rights of a country if there are reasonable doubts about its ability to deliver.
